with a history walk around **Toowong's business area**

The above buildings used to stand where Woolworths was later built. The streetscape here changed in the early 1900s when a spreading fire burnt many of these buildings down.

Join members of the Toowong and District Historical Society Inc. on a history walk around High and Jephson Streets and Sherwood Road.

These streets bounded what became Toowong's business district after the railway line was built from the mid-to-late 1870s.

When: 9.45am for a 10.00 am start, Sunday, 5th August, 2018.

Where: Meet at the Toowong Post Office Business Centre at 9.30am.

Length: Approximately 1½ hours.

What: The area to be walked is relatively flat, so would suit anyone with an moderate level of fitness.

Wear: Good walking shoes, a hat, sunscreen, bring water, and perhaps a small snack to be eaten while walking.

Book Stall: Publications on the history of Toowong will be available for sale.

Depending upon numbers the group may be split into smaller ones

As Toowong has a number of eateries and licensed premises, participants may wish to visit one of these afterwards for refreshments and lunch.
